

MASSAPEQUA SOCCER CLUB

Minutes of the Monthly Membership Meeting of the Massapequa Soccer Club held on Wednesday, March 19, 2014 at Birch Lane Elementary School, Massapequa NY.

The Monthly Membership Meeting of the Massapequa Soccer Club was called to order by President Kevin Ferrari at 8:06PM.

PRESIDENT'S COMMENTS:

Kevin announced that the club has secured extra training space at Berner Middle School. The Town of Oyster Bay along with Massapequa School District has arranged for portable lighting on the football field. We will be sharing the space with Lacrosse. Robin Lee will utilize the space for our weekly training grid. This extra space will allow for some of the older teams to get a third training session and/or have a ½ field for training. We are being asked to make sure that we park in the parking lot at Berner and not along the street. Only the gate from the parking lot will be open. We must communicate with TOB if the space will not be utilized.

The travel season has started, with weather pushing back the LIJSL one week. Teams that have LIJSL games scheduled for Soccer Park are encouraged to support the Long Island Cares Food Drive. All teams are expected to register for the MSC Memorial Day Tournament unless you have discussed your tournament plans with Rich Nuttall.

MSC Scholarship Applications are due April 1, 2014. At this time there has been only one application received. All MSC graduating seniors are eligible.

Kevin congratulated John O'Neill who was recognized by LIJSL as our 'Volunteer of the Year' for all the work he has done with our Finance Committee.

We are in need of a volunteer to work as a 'webmaster' to keep our website current. Anyone interested should contact a member of the Board.

At the last LIJSL Presidents' meeting there was a discussion about local clubs that have experienced losses due to a lack of oversight. Kevin acknowledged the great work that Yuri Fishman, Treasurer and the Finance Committee do for our club.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Treasurer Yuri Fishman reported that he along with Finance Committee met with our accounting firm, AVZ prior to tonight's meeting. All required tax returns have been filed and we are in the process of having our non-profit status reinstated. AVZ reviewed our current procedures and found no material weaknesses. We received an invoice from AVZ for the audits and return preparation for \$46,500.

A copy of our balance sheet and profit/loss statement through February 18, 2014 was made available for everyone.

Travel fee statements for the Spring season will be distributed next week and payable by the April meeting.

DIRECTOR OF COACHING REPORT:

Director of Coaching, Richard Nuttall expanded on the addition of Berner to the training grid. The field will be used to lighten the load on Burns and FOD thus giving teams more space to train. We are adding soccer arenas to the grass field at Burns that will be utilized by some of the younger age groups and clinics. This will again create more space for teams to train. Jon Adams added that Berner will allow our teams to get practice time in on a grass surface.

Hofstra University is hosting a soccer symposium April 10-12, 2014. The highlights of the soccer conference will be an appearance by legendary soccer icon, Pele. The conference will end with the NY Cosmos home opener. Prior to the Cosmos game, NY Cosmos and Hofstra University are hosting a handful of youth teams for a clinic. The GU11 Freedom/Storm will be representing MSC. Anyone interested in tickets to the game can see Eric Schmidt. Anyone interested in any of the other event taking place during the weekend can see Rich Nuttall.

Rich was happy to report that the BU17 Celtics beat the defending National Champion (Smithtown) 3-0 in a State Cup match. Rich reported that all of our older NPL teams are off to a tremendous start and the level of play continues to progress. The younger NPL teams continue to be challenged each weekend but he is happy with what he is seeing. Our U5-U8 programs kicked off last weekend. Typically there was a little confusion but for the most part things went well. Rich will be down at these sessions to reiterate to the parents the thoughts behind the program structure.

Rich introduced Stephen Roche, one of our senior core trainers.

Town of Oyster Bay is looking to host a college game in Massapequa this summer. Rich is working out the details and is hopeful that both the Hofstra Men and Women will be able to participate.

INTRAMURAL REPORT:

Denise Mushorn reported that the Intramural programs for U5-U8 started last weekend. We are looking to send some teams to the Rockville Centre Tournament for Memorial Day. All interested players should register on the Sports Signup site. Denise is looking for volunteers to help with administration of our annual Father's Day Tournament. At this time we are not sure if the rescheduled LIJSL games will have an impact on the tournament.

SERVICES REPORT:

Ed Murphy reported that the fields are ready to go. Walker is in very good shape and Anchor is coming along. He reminded teams that the nets at Walker must come down each night. We must make sure that all garbage is picked up and the fields are left in good

shape. Kevin reminded all that we do not pay for the use of any of our fields and it is vital to maintain them. Ed asked that all damaged equipment be reported as soon as possible.

BOYS/GIRLS TRAVEL REPORT:

Bob Muir reported that he and Bob Marose received PA Applications for the Fall 2014 season and will submit a list that will be included in the minutes. Fees for Travel teams will be out next week and we would like payments to be made prior to the April meeting.

COMMITTEES REPORT:

Kevin is looking to hold the MSC Golf Outing on Monday, June 30th. The venue is still being worked on. He would like to include a Hall of Fame piece to the event. Travel teams will be required to make a small donation. The majority of the proceeds will go to the Player Assistance Fund. Anyone interested in helping out should contact Kevin.

OPEN DISCUSSION:

The Snack Stand at Burns should be up and running in a few weeks. It was reported that the glass showcase in front of the Snack Stand has been damaged. It was suggested that we use the Snack Stand as the club's 'Lost & Found' area. It was mentioned from the floor that the communication tools within Sports Signup have been very helpful. It was recommended that all teams utilize the text feature.


